

Uniform Dress Code

All CPA students must be in uniform 261 days per year. You will receive two (2) warnings, either a written or a verbal communication of the uniform policy violation.

If after two (2) warnings your child is not in uniform, we will supply your child with a CPA approved shirt to wear. You will then be billed for the uniform.

When choosing your child's uniform, choose appropriate clothing including clothes the child can manage, undergarments that are convenient for toilet time, and shoes that are sturdy and comfortable for physical activity. Please write your child's name in all clothing and personal belongings.

Preschool Dress Code

- CPA polo shirt/t-shirts sold in school office- yellow, green and gray
- Plain turtleneck shirts- yellow, green and gray
- Blue jeans, navy, khaki pants, shorts, skirts or jumpers
- Lands' End plaid jumpers or skirts
- White peter pan blouse

Elementary Dress Code

- CPA polo shirt sold in school office- yellow, green and gray
- Plain turtleneck shirts- yellow, green and gray
- Navy or khaki pants, shorts, skirts or jumpers
- Lands' End plaid jumpers or skirts- no shorter than 3" above the knee
- Blue jeans only Fridays- no designs, cut-off or holes
- Undergarments should not show
- Earrings on post only- no dangling earrings
- Clothes should be appropriate size for a proper fit
- On Fridays, students may wear a CPA t-shirt or sweatshirt with blue jeans- t-shirts or sweatshirts may be purchased in the school office
